

CLASS OF 1969 SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. Name

A. This scholarship shall be known as the "Class of 1969 Scholarship".

2. Money

A. The funds for this scholarship shall be deposited in the First National Bank Northeast in the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation account under the name "Class of 1969 Scholarship".

3. Control

A. This scholarship shall be controlled by a committee composed of four (4) members of the class of 1969.

4. Amount

A. The amount of this scholarship shall be the interest accumulated annually on the certificate of deposit label "Class of 1969 Scholarship".

5. Frequency

A. This scholarship may or may not be awarded annually.

6. Eligibility

A. The applicant must be a senior at the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools.

B. The applicant must plan to attend and be accepted at some type of approved education beyond high school. This could be some type of college, vocational, business, trade or cosmetology school.

C. The applicant's financial needs will be a consideration.

D. The applicant must make formal application.

7. Disbursement

A. This scholarship shall be awarded at the beginning of the second term of the freshman year of college, normally in January.

1. If the student drops out of school before the award is given, he/she shall forfeit the scholarship award.

8. Selection

A. The committee shall determine who the recipients of the scholarship shall be. This shall be done prior to the date of senior graduation exercises each year.

9. Changes

A. Any changes governing this scholarship will be made by the committee.
