

WAYNE W. LOFTIS SCHOLARSHIP

1. NAME

This scholarship shall be known as the Wayne W. Loftis Scholarship.

2. FUNDS

Funds that support this scholarship are deposited within the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation in a separate account noted as "Wayne W. Loftis Scholarship".

3. CONTROL

This scholarship shall be controlled by three (3) trustees: the Tekamah-Herman Superintendent of Schools, a member of the Tekamah Herman School Board who represents Herman, and Cameron Jackson or, if not able to serve, a person appointed from the Herman community by the Board of the Herman Federated Church.

4. AMOUNT AND FREQUENCY

The amount of this scholarship shall be represented by the total interest accumulated by the Funds entitled "Wayne W. Loftis Scholarship". Two Tekamah-Herman seniors will be selected to share equally the funds generated by this scholarship fund. One recipient shall be a resident of the Herman area and the other recipient may be a resident from anywhere in said school district.

5. ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be graduating seniors attending Tekamah Herman Community Schools who have enrolled in a college program or some other advanced education program for the term commencing in the fall following their high school graduation.
2. Applicants must have maintained a good scholastic record during their high school year - 2.5 GPA or better.
3. Applicants must have demonstrated good citizenship at school and within their community.
4. Applicants must be people of integrity who are personable and respectful of the rights of others.
5. Trustees will consider financial need and show preference to students with the greatest needs.

6. DISBURSEMENT

The scholarship will be awarded at graduation ceremonies. A check will be awarded to each recipient during the second week of January following graduation and be used for expenses incurred during the second semester of the freshman year. The check will be made payable to the recipient and to the school he/she is attending.

7. CHANGES

Any changes to the Wayne W. Loftis Scholarship may only be done by the Trustees listed.
