

THE ARLIN LOWE MATH SCHOLARSHIP RULES

1. NAME

A. This scholarship shall be known as the "THE ARLIN LOWE MATH SCHOLARSHIP".

2. MONEY

A. The funds for this scholarship shall be deposited in a Certificate of Deposit in the First National Bank Northeast in the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation account under the name "THE ARLIN LOWE MATH SCHOLARSHIP" by May 1 of each school year.

3. CONTROL

A. This scholarship shall be controlled by a committee composed of Arlin Lowe, R. Dean Chase and two other adults.

4. NUMBER OF SCHOLARSHIPS

A. There shall be at least one (1) recipient of this award each school year.

5. AMOUNT

A. The amount of the scholarship shall be \$2,500.00.

6. FREQUENCY

A. This scholarship shall be awarded to a senior graduating from the Tekamah Herman Community Schools.

7. ELIGIBILITY

- A. The applicant must be a senior at the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools.
- B. The applicant must plan to attend and be accepted at some type of approved four year college.
- C. The applicants who are being considered for this scholarship shall have a cumulative grade point average of C (2.0) or above.
- D. The applicant must be enrolled in a math oriented college program. This could be, but will not be limited to, the field of engineering, any math oriented science or in the field of education where the applicant plans to become a secondary math teacher.
- E. The applicant's community-wide citizenship will be a consideration for the award of this scholarship.

F. The applicants must make formal application. Forms are available by clicking on Application Form at the bottom of this application. All applications must be returned to the Tekamah-Herman Counselor's Office by April 15.

8. DISBURSEMENT

A. This scholarship shall be awarded at senior graduation. Funds for this award will be dispersed at the beginning of the second term of the school year, usually in January. The check will be made payable to the student and the school he/she attends. Scholarships awarded but not used will be canceled and the amount thereof returned to the Certificate of Deposit housing The Arlin Lowe Math Scholarship funds.

9. SELECTION

A. The committee will determine the recipient of this scholarship. This shall be done prior to the date of commencement exercises.

10. CHANGES

A. Any changes governing this scholarship will be made as necessary by the committee.
