Parents:

The safety of our students is our top priority at Tekamah-Herman Elementary School. Please follow these guidelines to increase safety and efficiency during school dismissal each afternoon.

- Parents who choose to line "N" Street are to **STAY IN VEHICLES**. Do not park on the street and leave your vehicle. Doing so creates unnecessary and dangerous traffic congestion. Parking and leaving your vehicle unattended along the street may result in a citation from Tekamah Police Department.
- There is to be 1 line of cars only on "N" Street when picking up and dropping off before and after school. Please do not pull out of the line to go around other vehicles. Sometimes we have students that are getting in on both sides of their vehicle and we want to make sure they are safe.
- Parents who want to get out of their vehicles may park along the west side of the playground near the shuttle bus.
- There are also limited parking spaces available where staff park along "N" Street and along the east side of 14th Street.
- The highway should only be crossed at the light where we have an adult supervising.
- Students are not to be playing on the playground after school without a parent or adult supervising them.
