We are excited to be launching our Tekamah-Herman TeamMates chapter. TeamMates is a mentoring program founded by Tom and Nancy Osborne in 1991. We are focusing on matching students in grades 3rd-6th, who would like to have a mentor. Students can be nominated for the program by a teacher, parent, or other adult.
