## **TeamMates**

We are excited to be launching our Tekamah-Herman TeamMates chapter. TeamMates is a mentoring program founded by Tom and Nancy Osborne in 1991. Mentees are matched with an adult mentor who will meet with them once a week at school during the school year, continuing throughout their school years. We are focusing on matching students in grades 3rd-6th, who would like to have a mentor. Students can be nominated for the program by a teacher, parent, or other adult. Students can also be self-nominated. If a student is nominated, wants to participate, and has received parent permission, the matching process will begin. Not all students will be matched right away. TeamMates places a high importance on the quality of the mentor/mentee matches. Matches are created based on commonalities and the greatest possibility for a long-time match. Students will find out more about the TeamMates program when TeamMates representative DeMoine Adams gives a presentation at school on September 5th, to all students 3rd grade and older.
