

## **JACK FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP**

Lucile Jack Payne and Howard K. Payne wish to contribute funds for a scholarship in memory of Mrs. Payne's sister, Dorothy Jack Christianson and parents, Arthur H. Jack and Dora Laucomer Jack. Mrs. Christianson was a graduate of Tekamah Public Schools and a dedicated teacher and school principal.

### **1. NAME**

This scholarship shall be known as the Jack Family Scholarship.

### **2. FUNDING**

The funds for the scholarship shall be deposited for investment in the First National Bank Northeast in the Tekamah-Herman Public School Foundation account under the name of Jack Family Scholarship.

### **3. AMOUNT**

The amount of the scholarship will be 96% of the previous yearly interest accumulated on the principal of the account listed as the "Jack Family Scholarship".

### **4. CONTROL**

The scholarship will be controlled by a committee selected by the Foundation. The committee shall consist of three to five (3-5) members. No member of the selected committee shall take part in the deliberations in any year in which a member of such person's family is an applicant.

### **5. FREQUENCY**

The scholarship(s) shall be controlled by a committee selected by the Foundation. The recipient may receive the scholarship in successive years from one (1) to four (4) at the discretion of the committee.

### **6. ELIGIBILITY**

- A. The applicant must be a high school senior at or a former graduate of the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools.
- B. The applicant must be planning to go into the teaching profession.
- C. The applicant must plan to attend or be accepted by an approved college or university with an accredited program in Education. The committee should give strong consideration to persons who wish to change careers to that of teaching or a homemaker who wishes to go back to school to become a teacher.

D. Applicants must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or above (a B average).

E. The applicant must make formal application for this award. Forms are available by clicking on Application Form at the bottom of this application.

## **7. AVAILABILITY**

The foundation shall publish a notice in the Burt County Plaindealer at an appropriate time to advise former graduates of the availability of the scholarship. Students presently in high school will be informed as with all other scholarships available to them.

## **8. SELECTION**

Applicants shall be judged on scholarship, financial need and a strong interest and enthusiasm for teaching. Applicants shall make formal application to the Foundation on the designated form. The committee shall review the applications and award the scholarship.

The selection shall be done prior to the date of graduation exercises each year. A copy of the applications will be sent to Mrs. Payne each year and the committee will advise Mrs. Payne of the year's recipient(s).

## **9. DISBURSEMENT**

The scholarship (s) shall be disbursed annually at the beginning of the second term of the school year, usually in January. The check will be made payable to both the student and the institution of higher learning. Scholarships awarded but not used within one year of the granting of the award shall be cancelled and the money redeposited in the Jack Family Scholarship to become available for the next year's scholarship.
