

JEZEK SCHOLARSHIP FUND

1. Name:

This endowment fund shall be known as the Jezek Scholarship Fund.

2. Money:

The Omaha Community Foundation shall hold the funds for this scholarship fund as per the agreement established.

3. Control:

The scholarship will be controlled by a committee selected by the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation and the Tekamah-Herman School District. The committee selected shall include, as a minimum, the current superintendent of the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools, one counselor representing the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools, R. Dean Chase and two (2) Directors of the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation. No member of the selected committee shall take part in the deliberations in any year in which a member of such person's family is an applicant. The selection procedure shall require no discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex or national origin.

4. Frequency:

The scholarship(s) shall be awarded annually at the ceremony when other scholarships are presented, usually at graduation ceremonies in May. The recipient may receive the scholarship in successive years from one (1) to four (4) years upon reapplication by the recipient.

5. Eligibility:

- A. The applicant must be a high school senior at or a former graduate of the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools.
- B. The applicant must plan to attend or be accepted at an approved post high school training institution, including, but not limited to, university, college, vocational, trade or business school. Since there are more scholarships available for graduating seniors than there are for past graduates, the Foundation should give strong consideration to applicants who have been out of high school one or more years.
- C. Applicants who are in high school must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 2.5 or above and applicants who have obtained some post high school education must have a cumulative post high school grade point average of 2.5 or above.
- D. Applicants shall be judged on scholarship, community involvement and financial needs.
- E. Applicants shall make formal application to the Foundation on the designated form.

F. The Tekamah-Herman Schools shall publish a notice in the Burt County Plaindealer at an appropriate time to advise former graduates of this scholarship and its availability.

6. Disbursement:

The scholarship shall be disbursed annually at the beginning of the second term of the school year, usually in January. The check will be made payable to both the student and the institution of higher learning. Scholarships awarded but not used within one year of the granting of the award shall be canceled and the amount thereof shall become available for scholarships the following year.

7. Selection:

The committee selected by the Foundation will review the applications and award the scholarship(s). The selection shall be done prior to the date of graduation exercises each year. The amount of each scholarship will be determined by the selection committee and will be based upon factors contained within the completed applications.
