

HENRY BAYARD JOHNSON AND GLADYS WESGAARD JOHNSON
SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is given in memory of Henry Bayard Johnson and Norma Wesgaard Johnson. It will be funded by a donation to the Tekamah-Herman Public Schools Foundation in the amount of \$15,000.00. The interest income from this donation will fund one scholarship each year as described below. Applicants, as stated in the Will of Norma Johnson Mueller, should be a "deserving, intelligent young person from the Tekamah area--".

1. Name:

This scholarship shall be know as the Henry Bayard Johnson and Gladys Wesgaard Johnson Scholarship.

2. Money:

The funds for this scholarship shall be deposited for investment in the First National Bank Northeast in the Tekamah-Herman Public School Foundation account under the name of Henry Bavard Johnson and Gladys Wesgaard Johnson Scholarship.

3. Amount:

The amount of the scholarship will be the previous yearly interest accumulated on the principal of the account listed as the the Henry Bayard Johnson and Gladys Wesgaard Johnson Scholarship and will be used for one (1) scholarship.

4. Control:

The scholarship will be controlled by a committee selected by the Foundation. No member of the selected committee shall take part in the deliberations in any year in which a member of such person's family is an applicant. The committee shall be made up of the high school counselor, a board member of the Tekamah-Herman Foundation and the high school principal.

5. Frequency:

The scholarship(s) shall be awarded annually at the ceremony when other scholarships are presented, usually at graduation ceremonies.

6. Eligibility:

A. The applicant must be a high school senior at or a former graduate of the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools.

B. The applicant must plan to attend or be accepted at an approved post-high school training institution, including, but not limited to, university, college, vocational, trade or business school.

C. Applicants who are in high school must have a cumulative high school grade point average of 3.0 or above (a B average), and applicants who have obtained some post-high school education must have a cumulative post-high school grade point average of 3.0 or above.

D. Applicants shall be judged on scholarship, community involvement and financial needs.

E. Applicants shall make formal application. Form are available by clicking on Application Form at the bottom of this application. Applications are due in the counselor's office by April 15.

7. Disbursement:

The scholarship shall be disbursed annually at the beginning of the second term of the school year, usually in January. The check will be made payable to both the student and the institution of higher learning. Scholarships awarded but not used within one year of the granting of the award shall be canceled and the amount thereof shall become available for scholarships the following year.

8. Selection:

The committee selected by the Foundation will review applications and award the scholarship. The selection shall be done prior to the date of graduation exercises each year.
