

KENNETH LANGE-MCGILL SCHOLARSHIP

1. NAME

This Scholarship shall be known as the KENNETH LANGE-MCGILL SCHOLARSHIP.

2. MONEY

The funds for this scholarship shall be deposited for investment in the First National Bank Northeast in the Tekamah-Herman Public School Foundation account under the name of KENNETH LANGE-MCGILL SCHOLARSHIP

3. AMOUNT

The amount of the scholarship will be the previous yearly interest accumulated on the principal of the account listed as the KENNETH LANGE-MCGILL SCHOLARSHIP and will be used for (1) scholarship.

4. CONTROL

The scholarship will be controlled by a committee of five (5) composed of a high school principal, the high school guidance counselor, a representative of the Blue Lodge and two (2) community women appointed by the superintendent of the high school.

5. FREQUENCY

This scholarship shall be awarded annually at the ceremony when other scholarships are presented. The recipient may receive it from one (1) to four (4) years and upon reapplication by the recipient.

6. ELIGIBILITY

- A. The applicant must be a graduating senior at or a former graduate of the Tekamah-Herman Community Schools
- B. The applicant must plan to attend and be accepted by some type of approved education beyond high school. This may be a four (4) year college, a vocational school, a trade school or a business school.
- C. The applicant must have a G.P.A. of at least 3.0.
- D. The applicant must show evidence of having worked to his/her potential.
- E. The applicant's financial need as well as community-wide citizenship will be considered for awarding this scholarship.

F. The applicant must make formal application. Forms are available by clicking on Application Form at the bottom of this application.

7. DISBURSEMENT

This scholarship shall be disbursed annually at the beginning of the second term of school, usually in January. The check will be made out to both the recipient and the school he/she is attending.

8. SELECTION

The committee will determine the recipient of this scholarship. This shall be done prior to the date of graduation exercises each year.

9. CHANGES

Any changes governing the scholarship will be made by the committee.

10. AWARD CEREMONY

At the award presentation a message compiled by the donors is to be communicated, orally or in writing, to the recipient to give a brief history of the scholarship and to provide best wishes to the awardee.

This scholarship is given through the generosity of Kenneth McGill, M. Marian McGill Wood and Erma McGill Ovenden all graduates of the Tekamah High School. Each believed in higher education and worked toward that goal. Kenneth was elected to Phi Beta Kappa when he graduated from the University of Nebraska and was awarded a Doctor of Philosophy Degree by the University of Michigan. Marian, a University of Nebraska graduate, completed professional nurse study at the Johns Hopkins Hospital and earned a Master of Arts Degree at Columbia University. Erma attained honors at the Lincoln School of Commerce.

Kenneth and Marian attained basic degrees without financial aid but both earned advanced degrees through scholarships and this made them aware of the importance of monetary aid.
