# What is the Title I Program?

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- Title I is one part of the EVERY STUDENT SUCCEEDS ACT (ESSA).
- Title I is a federally funded program that provides support for students and groups of students who are at risk of not meeting NSCAS standards.
- Tekamah-Herman is a Schoolwide Title I program. This means that any student may received Title I assistance.

# What Does Title I Look Like In Our School?

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- Structures are in place to support at-risk students and monitor student learning:
  - Students are screened using Acadience Math, Acadience Reading, and MAP
  - Individual student plans are used to monitor goals, interventions and progress
  - Individual/small group instructional time is added
  - Student progress is monitored weekly during PLC meetings

# What Is An Individual Student Plan?

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- An Individual Student Plan is a plan of action used to accelerate a student's learning in order to move toward grade level reading/math proficiency.
- A major component is providing an **INTERVENTION**: Additional, intensive, focused and appropriate instruction provided to students who are struggling with reading/math.
- Another major component is **PROGRESS MONITORING**: Occuring weekly – the results of this type of progress monitoring inform instructional decisions.
